I. CALL TO ORDER

II. 2019-2020 BUDGET OVERVIEW TO THE PUBLIC

The Board held an informational meeting for the public so community members could provide input on the budget prior to approval. Superintendent Benigni provided a slideshow of the Proposed Operating Budget for 2019-2020. A copy of the presentation was provided to Board members and available to the audience. Superintendent Benigni indicated the budget reflects the district's priorities: purpose, passion and pride and that a school district's budget reflects the commitment of the community to invest in the future of the children. The erosion of funding for education challenges the sustainability of Berlin as a competitive school district with rich educational and extracurricular opportunity for students. The slideshow presentation consisted of students' accomplishments; the 2019-2020 proposed budget overview; new staff requests, which also included those requests that did not make it to the budget; five-year average of Berlin's adopted budgets; budget funding history; net current expenditure per pupil; Berlin and State per pupil expenditure; federal funding; student enrollment; projected enrollments; five year FTE comparisons for administrators, teachers/certified staff, paraprofessionals, clerical, custodians, cook managers, food service and unaffiliated staff; a budget executive summary; Special Education costs; Capital Equipment Budget; and Site and Building Budget.
