Dear Parents/Guardians:

On Tuesday, April 24, 2018, the voters of Berlin will have the opportunity to vote on the **2018-2019 Budget** for the town of Berlin as recommended by the Berlin Town Council.

The ballot shall read as follows:

“Question 1. Shall the proposed general government budget for the 2018-2019 fiscal year be adopted? Yes. No.”

“Advisory Question 1. If you voted no on the general government budget, is the budget....Too High. Too Low.”

“Question 2. Shall the proposed Board of Education budget for the 2018-2019 fiscal year be adopted? Yes. No.”

“Advisory Question 2. If you voted no on the Board of Education Budget, is the budget....Too High. Too Low.”

The polling places will be open from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. and they are as follows:

District 1	Willard School , 1088 Norton Road
District 2	American Legion , 154 Porters Pass
District 3	Hubbard School , 139 Grove Street, East Berlin
District 4	Senior Center , 31 Colonial Drive
District 5	Griswold School , 133 Heather Lane

I encourage you to exercise your right to vote in this important referendum. Mark the date...Tuesday, April 24.
